BOULDER BANK Pinot Noir

The wine is comprised from the Waxeye Vineyard on Hawkesbury Road on an undulated property with great air flow and gravelly loam soil. Site specific winemaking is utilized, and each vine receives many visits per year for hand work, bringing it to its full potential. These vines produce wines with red cherry and blueberry fruit notes and soft, supple tannins.

Winemaker Nick Goldschmidt's first vintage in New Zealand was in 1982. He continues his craft today there and in other New World appellations.
